

## Social and economic structures in Babylonia in the Old Babylonian period - the evidence of the letters

The aim of the project is to provide


- •an overview of unpublished and published Old Babylonian letters,
- •indices of personal names, toponyms, theonyms as well as lemmata,
- reconstruction of dossiers according to the provenance and senders.
- •A database with the transcriptions of the texts and all the relevant information is being prepared by us.

As part of the project also a general revision of the tablets already published in AbB is intended. As for the unpublished texts, a screening of the collections of different museums is under way.





As part of our project we study in the short and middle term about 400 unpublished Old Babylonian letters kept in the Yale Babylonian Collection. They have been already catalogued, photographed, transcribed and copied.
